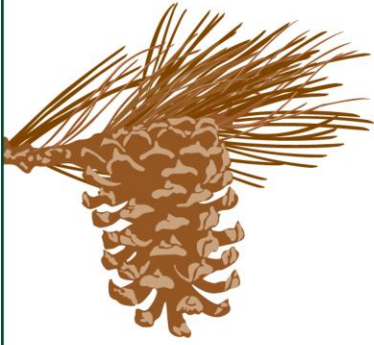


Volunteer with the National Forest Association Great Seeds Restoration Program!
